ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MALTA, IDAHO,
SETTING THE TIME FOR OPENING AND CLOSING
THE POLLS AT ALL GENERAL AND SPECIAL CITY
ELECTIONS; REPEALING ANY EXISTING
ORDINANCES ON OPENING AND CLOSING POLLS;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MALTA:

Section 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE: The City Council of the
City of Malta, hereby finds:

1.1 The size of the City, volume of registered
voters within the City, and the volume of voters appearing at
General and Special City elections in the past does not justify
opening of the polls at 8:00 a.m. on election day, with the
polls remaining open until 8:00 p.m. of the same day.

1.2 The City Council further finds that eight (8)
hours is a sufficient time, for the polls to remain open, to
fully accommodate all registered electors of the City of Malta
at all General and Special City elections.

Section 2. OPENING AND CLOSING POLLS. At all General
and Special elections of the City of Malta the polls shall be
opened at 12:00 Noon and shall remain open until all registered
electors of the City of Malta have voted or until 8:00 p.m. of
the same day, whichever comes first.

Section 3. REPEALER. All Ordinances and parts of
Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance
are hereby repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take

effect immediately upon final passage and publication as

provided by law.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MALTA, IDAHO, SETTING THE TIME FOR OPENING AND CLOSING THE POLLS AT ALL GENERAL AND SPECIAL CITY ELECTIONS; REPEALING ANY EXISTING ORDINANCES ON OPENING AND CLOSING POLLS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MALTA:
Section 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE:
The City Council of the City of Malta, hereby finds:
1.1 The size of the City, volume of registered voters within the City, and the volume of voters appearing at General and Special City elections in the past does not justify opening of the polls at 8:00 a.m. on election day, with the polls remaining open until 8:00 p.m. of the same day.
1.2 The City Council further finds that eight (8) hours is a sufficient time, for the polls to remain open, to fully accommodate all registered electors of the City of Malta at all General and Special City elections.
Section 2. OPENING AND CLOSING POLLS. At all General and Special elections of the City of Malta the polls shall be opened at 12:00 Noon and shall remain open until all registered electors of the City of Malta have voted or until 8:00 p.m. of the same day, whichever comes first.
Section 3. REPEALER. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
