THERETO SHALL BE ON FILE IN
THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK;
REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES
IN CONFLICT HERewith AND
FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR
AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MALTA,
IDA HO:

Section 1: There is hereby adopted
for the purpose of regulating and con-
trolling measures which will provide
that degree of public safety from fire
which can be reasonably required,
while avoiding unreasonable hardships
or unnecessary inconvenience or in-
terference with normal use and oc-
cupancy of buildings and structures
within the City of Malta, Idaho, the
Life Safety Code, 1973 Edition, NFPA
No. 101, prepared by the National Fire
Protection Association, 470 Atlantic
Avenue, Boston, MA 02210, and
published by the National Fire Protec-
tion Association, 1973 Edition, thereof
and as the same may hereafter by
revised or amended. And the same is
hereby adopted and incorporated as an
ordinance of the City as fully as
though set forth at length herein.

Section 2: Three copies of the
Uniform Building Code, 1973 Edition,
together with all amendments thereto,
duly certified by the City Clerk, shall
be kept on file in his office for use
and examination of and by the public.

Section 3: All ordinances of the City
of Malta, Idaho, in conflict herewith
are hereby repealed.

its passage, approval, and publication.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MALTA, IDAHO:
